Dear Jan

This is a letter to you and your company thanking you for your amazing recent support to our Ukraine missions.

We are a collection of volunteers who deliver all types of aid to the now worn torn country of Ukraine. We don't have charitable status or a command structure we just agree to work together and every few months send teams out to Ukraine to help where ever is needed.

For me the appeal of traveling to the Ukraine had never past my head until I met a group of ex-military vets, they were told by other volunteers that a lot of aid never reached the towns and villages behind the front lines in Ukraine as aid agencies had deemed too dangerous for their teams. They asked me would I be interested in coming with them and using my pickup truck to deliver aid last year so I agreed and went on my first trip. The thing I like about these groups I work with is they use their own vehicles and for gathering aid they

reach out to their local community and fill the trucks up with that aid every time.

I have never done anything like this before so when I told my family I was going to drive to Ukraine and that once there I would be operating around the front lines they were not very happy and very concerned to say the least! I'm a manager at Firstport retirement homes, so when I told my residents they to were also concerned but at the same time collected 100s of shoe boxes full of toys for the orphanages we were going to.

When the day came to go it dawned on me that I was driving 2500 plus miles across Europe to one of the most war-torn places on the planet, I was excited to be taking aid but also a bit worried to what might happen in Ukraine itself. The trip through Europe went well and before I knew it I was in Ukraine proper, we took some trauma kits to 3 local hospitals then drove east towards the front lines and dropped the children's shoe box gifts to 2 orphanages.

The kids were absolutely thrilled and for me made the trip worthwhile, it was later that day we got a call from the mayor of a town just behind the front lines that there were desperate for and medical equipment we could spare, we did have some first aid kits left but would have to drive another 700 miles to where he was. I agreed and we drove to where he was, and they greeted us so kindly, but we felt bad we could not have brought more aid to them.

So, its 2024 and I'm going back to Ukraine again but this time thanks from your generous donation we can field 2 trucks and double our efforts!

I will keep you posted on our mission and again would like to thank everyone connected with your company for stepping in and support us
